

## **Notes to the Contributors**

Lekshmipuram College Bulletin on Research (LPCBR) is a bi-annual peer reviewed multi-disciplinary institutional journal published by Lekshmi Research Cell of Lekshmipuram College of Arts and Science, Neyyoor. Articles from Tamil, English, Malayalam, History, Economics, Commerce, Social-Science, Physical and Life Sciences, Computer Science, Library and Information Science and related discipline are welcome. It also entertains meritorious articles from research scholars and faculty both in and outside the college area. The articles submitted for publication in this journal should not have been published previously or submitted elsewhere and that are not under review for another publication in any media. (e.g. Printed or on-line Journal, conference proceedings)

An assurance, promising the originality and nowhere published statement is necessary from the author. The first author should give the statement for co-authors' article.

All the papers received for publication in the Journal are subjected to refereeing by respective experts in the field.

### **Format**

Research papers with a maximum of 6000 words and the review articles not exceeding 5000 words should be neatly typed on one side of the A4 size paper in double spacing with font size 12pt on Times New Roman. Two copies of the paper should be submitted along with the soft copy. Page number, header and footer should not be included. Articles in Tamil should be typed on Unicode format. Since the scope of the journal is multi-disciplinary, authors are requested to follow the latest writing manual in their respective subjects. Tables and figures either shall be attached separately with captions or along with the text in continuation.

The title page should include: title of the article, name(s) of author(s), affiliation(s), and the contact person to whom communications should be sent.

### **Abstract**

An abstract not exceeding one hundred words should be attached with the manuscripts along with five to eight key words.

### **Reference**

List of references must be provided at the end of the paper and they should be arranged in the order of citation in the text.

Contributors can follow a standard style relevant to the respective subjects.

### **Abbreviation**

Non-standard abbreviations should be shown in brackets where they are first mentioned and these abbreviations should be used whenever the same terms appear again in the text. These abbreviations should however, be kept to a minimum and should not be used in the title and in the abstract.
