(a) **Tsunami Relief Camp. (26.12.2004 to 06.01.2005)**

Lekshmiipuram College of Arts & Science is situated near a coastal belt. The coastal hamlets are Mondaicaud – Pudur, Kottipadu, Azhikal and Colachel. When the Tsunami struck the coastal belt at about 10am on 26.12.2004, the affected fisher folk numbering 624 immediately sought asylum in the college. All the rooms except the laboratory and administrative building for open to them and were given accommodation. On 27.12.04 and on 28.12.04 also 836 and 1140 people respectively sought asylum. **In all 2745 people were accommodated.** The Management had further taken steps on war footing to provide water,

clothes and food; It had also **engaged** the Medical Practitioners of the nearby P.S. Medical Trust, Thalakulam, **our Referral Hospital** to look after their health.

The Secretary, the President and the other Executive Committee members of the College Committee, the members of the Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff and the Students, all had bestowed their personal attention to the Tsunami Camp and turned good Samaritans. The Government entered the field later. Until then the college provided them food and other facilities. **A number of VIPs of the Central Government, State Government and Public including the former Prime Minister Mr. Deva Gouda, Mr. L. K. Advani, Mr. Vai.Ko, Mr. G. K. Vasan, Mr. M. K. Stalin, Mr. Vijaya Kanth and Hon'able Ministers of Government of Tamil Nadu, Messrs. Thalavai Sundaram, Nainar Nagendran and Jeya Raman visited the Camp.**

NCC and NSS Units 78,79,84 & 85 also actively participated in the Tsunami Relief Camp.

The Tsunami Relief Camp in the campus was from 26.12.2004 to 06.01.2005 (12 Days) Atmospheric pressure data is being supplied regularly to the International Cancer Centre, Neyyoor.
