1.4.1: Feedback on Curriculum –Students

Feedback on the curriculum from the students is collected using Google Forms at the end of the academic year 2023-24, the responses are analysed and summarized as follows:

1. Forty percent of the students strongly agree that the existing curriculum is designed to improve employability, 48.6 percent agree, and 9.2 percent are neutral. However, the remaining students disagree.
2. Thirty-nine percent of the students strongly agree that the syllabus prescribed for their programmes is contemporary in subject areas and need-based; 47.9 percent agree, 8.9 percent are neutral, and the remaining 3.5 percent disagree.
3. Regarding the order of content matter in the prescribed courses, which are easy to difficult, simple to complex, and concrete to abstract, 34.5 percent strongly agree, 49.3 percent agree, 10.6 percent are neutral, and the remaining disagree.
4. Thirty-two percent of the students strongly agree that sufficient reference material and related books and other resources are available for the topics mentioned in the syllabus and are available in the library; 46.5 percent agree, 11.3 percent are neutral, and the remaining disagree.
5. Thirty-eight percent of the students strongly agree that different courses offered in their degree programme are relevant and revised at regular intervals, the same is agreed by 45.8 percent, 13.4 percent in neutral and the remaining disagree.
6. The majority of the students (51.4 percent) agree that the content of the course conform with the learning outcomes, 34.5 percent strongly agree, 9.9 percent in neutral and the remaining disagree.
7. Forty-six percent of the students strongly agree that the course prescribed for them have enhance their knowledge, skills and capabilities, 43.7 percent agree, 6.3 percent in neutral and the remaining disagree.
8. Forty-five percent of the students agree that the entire syllabus prescribed for them is completed within the stipulated period of time, 40 percent strongly agree, 7 percent are neutral, and the remaining disagree.

9. Forty-seven percent of the students agree that the scope for using ICT-based teaching aids and teachers are using ICT tools in the class, the same strongly agree 27.5 percent 14.8 percent in neutral and the remaining disagree.
10. Forty-one percent of the students strongly agree that the assessment evaluation process practiced in the institution is fair and unbiased, 42.3 percent agree, 12 percent are neutral and the remaining disagree.
